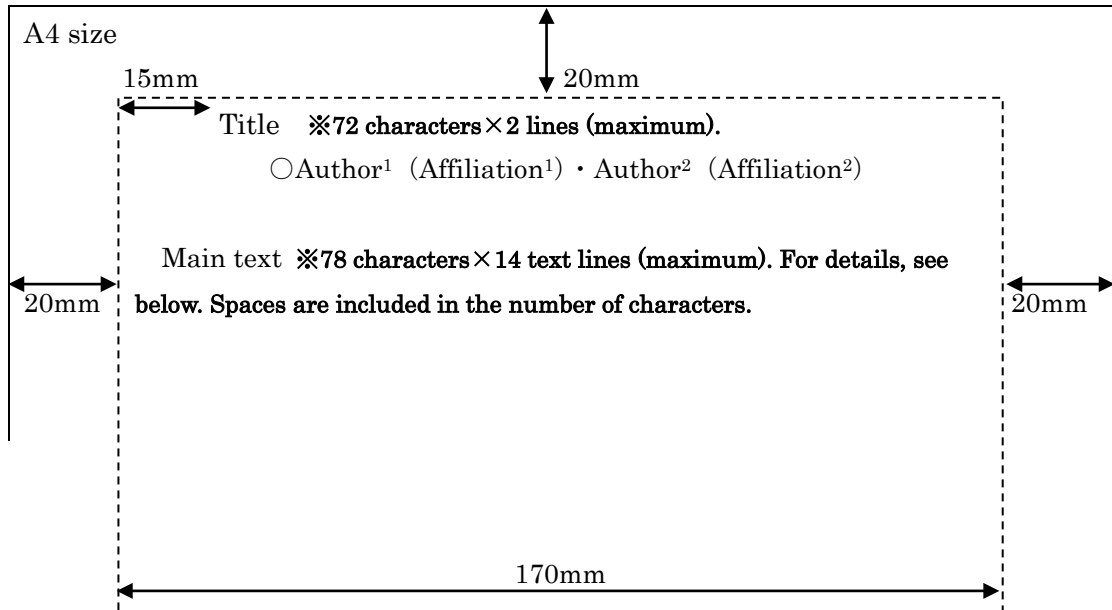


INSTRUCTION FOR ABSTRACT PREPARATION

[1] Abstract is automatically type-set as shown below. The following limitations apply to the number of characters in an abstract.



- 1) Total number of lines including the title, authors (affiliation), and main text should not exceed 16. Maximum number of characters in each line is 72, 68, and 78 for the title, authors (affiliation), and main text, respectively.
- 2) The title should be presented within the first two lines.
- 3) Affiliations should be abbreviated (< 20 characters for each).
- 4) Maximum number of lines in the main text is 14 or less, depending on the lengths of the title, authors, and affiliations. The total number of characters in the main text should not exceed 936.
